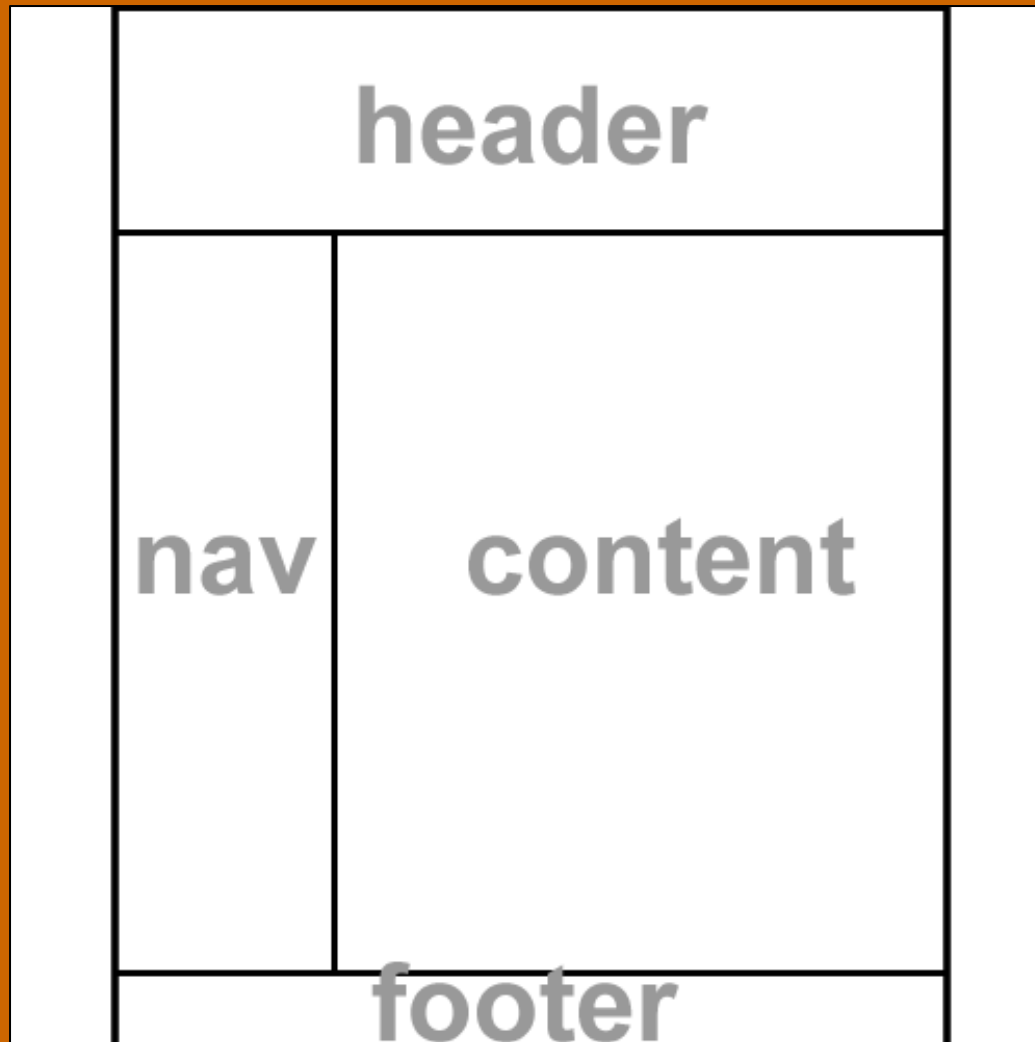
Every good website has?

4. Footer

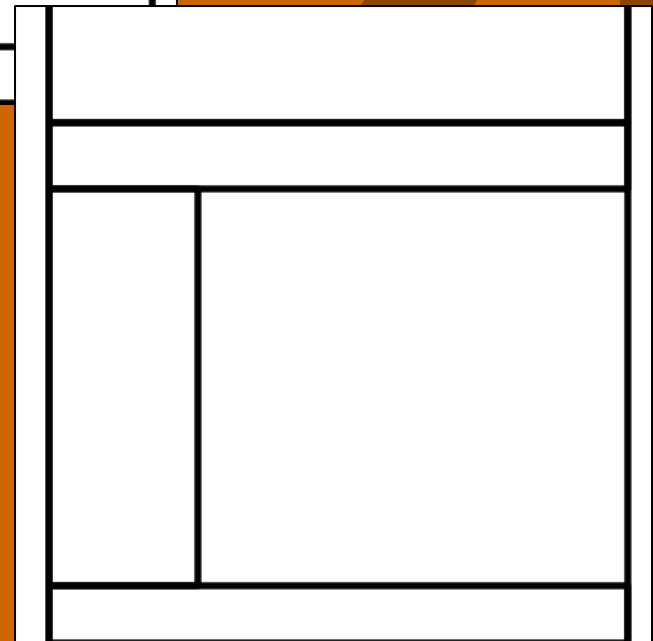
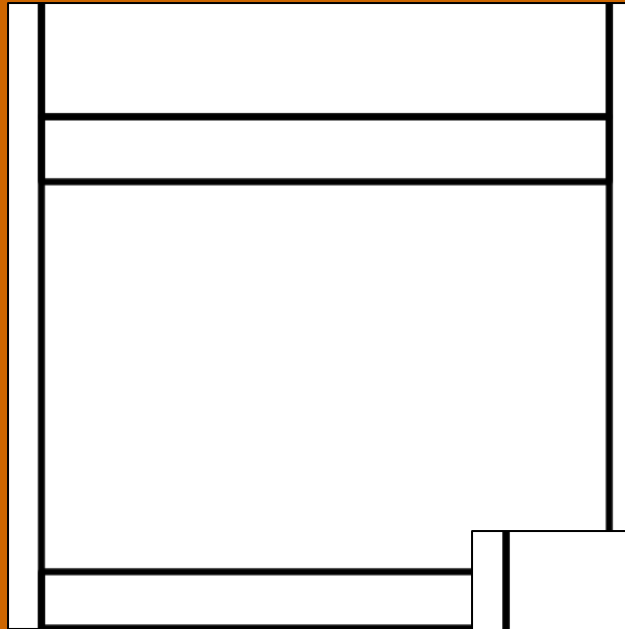
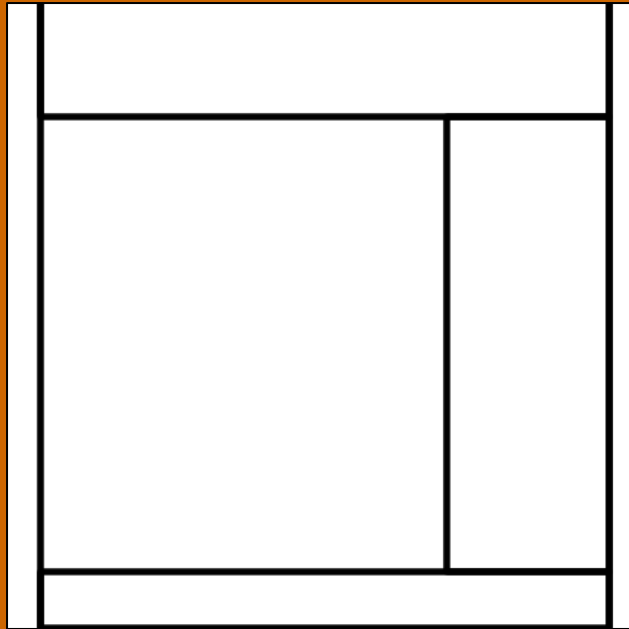
